

A.S. Kang (Kang Ah Sim) was born in Kedah in 1951. Despite the absence of any formal art education, Kang managed to establish himself as a prominent artist in the competitive art world through his relentless hard works and fiery passion towards art. In particular, Kang is widely celebrated in the art world as "The King of Koi," renowned for his extraordinary ability to capture the vibrant energy of koi fish and the dynamic flow of water.

As a jack in all pots, Kang is skilled in a wide range of media including acrylic, Chinese ink painting & calligraphy and even sculpturing. This is especially surprising given that all of these are learnt from the artist's self-taught processes. As the Vice President of the North Kedah Art Society (2001 - 2018), Kang's collectors include the National Art Gallery, Bank Negara Malaysia, the New Straits Times Press and other private sectors.

Kang has showcased his work in numerous group exhibitions at Younie Gallery, Kuala Lumpur, including 'Golden Brush III' (2018), a tribute to veteran local artists over 60. He has also participated in international art expos, such as the Artists Art Fair Malaysia (2014) held at Stadium Chinwoo, Kuala Lumpur.

Hailing from Kuching, the late Kueh Chai Phiaw was a dedicated classical Chinese ink artist. In 1962, Kueh studied fine arts at the Taiwan Normal University, where he was directly taught under important art masters including Huang Junbi, Lin Yushan, Pu Xinyu, Liao Jichun and Ma Baishui. Upon returning to Malaysia, he committed himself to both artistic creation and art education, teaching art in several high schools. In 2008, he was recognised as "The First-Generation Artists in Sarawak" by the state government. In 2015, his solo Chinese ink exhibition was held at Younie Gallery, Kuala Lumpur. In 2017, an exhibition in memory of him was held at Boonia Art Gallery, Kuching.

The late Professor Chung Chen Sun, a prominent artist and art educator, was known as the "Father of Malaysian Modern Art Education". Graduated from Singapore's Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts, he was taught under key Nanyang art pioneers: Chen Wen Hsi, Chen Chong Swee, Cheong Soo Pieng, and Georgette Chen. He founded multiple art colleges in Malaysia and China, including the famous Malaysian Institute of Art (MIA). He exhibited across over 20 countries and held 30 solo shows. His artworks made their debut at the China Guardian Hong Kong auction in 2020. In 2011, The Chung Chen Sun Art Museums were established in Kuala Lumpur and China.



钟正山教授毕业于新加坡南洋美术专科学校,师承陈文希、陈宗瑞、钟泗宾,1984年获得美国三藩市大学公共行政管理硕士学位。他在马来西亚及中国创办了五所艺术学院,包括1967年创办的马来西亚艺术学院,对现代艺术教育产生影响,因而被誉为"马来西亚现代艺术教育之父"。他亦积极参与国际艺术教育交流,80年代中期担任过亚太区艺术教育会议(ASPACAE)轮值主席;1982年,与台湾管执中共同发起成立「国际现代水墨画联盟」,并担任主席10年,在中国水墨画的现代化进程中发挥了作用。他亦以"马来西亚现代水墨画之父"著称,其创新的艺术作品在20多个国家地区的国际大展中展出,并举办了30次个人画展,受到博物馆、美术馆、政府机构、企业和私人收藏家的青睐。他的作品也曾于中国嘉德香港2020秋季拍卖会上亮相。2011年,钟正山美术馆于吉隆坡及中国正式成立。



Li Yu has held numerous solo exhibitions held across China, Malaysia, and more. His works has been collected by the former Malaysian Prime Minister Tun Dr Mahathir. He has been featured in publications such as China's "People's Daily" and Xinhua News Agency, as well as Malaysia's national televisions and Sin Chew Daily. Li Yu's remarkable journey is chronicled through various painting collections that he has published.

In 1998, he began learning Chinese ink painting from Dr Cheah Thien Soong. Lai was an art lecturer for the Malaysian Institute of Art (MIA) Chinese ink correspondence course and Kuantan "Qing Liang Art Studio". Selected exhibitions include the Australian International Lingnan Art Exhibition, Australia (1990); the 1st China-Malaysia International Ornamental Stone & Calligraphy Exhibition, China (2007); "The Different Wonder of Chinese Ink" solo show, Kuala Lumpur (2010); "Me and My Stories" solo show, Younie Gallery, Kuala Lumpur (2013), and China-ASEAN Contemporary Chinese Ink Exhibition, China (2014).



Mentored by the Sarawakian art pioneer - Tsai Horng Chung, Lam honed his skills through plein-air studies and won drawing competitions. Influenced by modern artists like Paul Klee and Mark Rothko, Lam has exhibited internationally since 1970 and won awards such as the Winsor & Newton worldwide painting competition (2000), Sarawak State-Wide Art Award (1988), the China Jiangsu Watercolour Research Institute Honour Medal (2007), the First Sarawak Generation Fine Art Artist Award (2008), and the Malaysian National Art Gallery's 'Salut 55' Honorary Award (2013).

Since 1970, Lam has participated in numerous exhibitions nationally and internationally across Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, Taiwan, Hong Kong, mainland China, Korea, Japan, Australia, Sweden, Belgium, England, and the United States. 



Loo Foh Sang graduated from the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA) in Singapore in 1965 and the École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris in 1969. He trained in printmaking under Stanley William Hayter at Atelier 17 in Paris, a key 20th-century printmaking workshop. Loo spent over two decades in Paris, establishing a studio and mastering printmaking, alongside oil painting, Chinese ink painting, and sketching.





1. DEFINITIONS IN THESE CONDITIONS:

2. BIDDING PROCEDURES AND THE BUYER

- 2.1 Bidders are required to register their particulars before bidding and to satisfy any security arrangements before entering the auction room to bid.
- 2.2 The maker of the highest bid accepted by the auctioneer conducting the sale shall be the buyer at the hammer price and any dispute about a bid shall be settled at the auctioneer's absolute discretion by reoffering the Lot during the course of the auction or otherwise. The auctioneer shall act reasonably in exercising this discretion.
- 2.3 Bidders shall be deemed to act as principals.
- 2.4 Our right to bid on behalf of the consignor is expressly reserved up to the amount of any reserve and the right to refuse any bid is also reserved.

3. INCREMENTS

4. BUYER'S PREMIUM

6. TITLE AND COLLECTION OF PURCHASES

- 6.1The ownership of any Lots purchased shall not pass to you until you have made payment in full to us of the total amount due.
- 6.2 You shall at your own risk and expense take away any lots that you have purchased and paid for not later than 7 days following the day of the auction after which you shall be responsible for any removal, storage and insurance charges.

7. SHIPPING

7.1 Transfer of Risk

7.2 Packing, handling and shipping

The packing, handling and shipping of lot is entirely at the buyer's risk and expense (which shall be paid in full before the lot is shipped out) and YA shall not, in any circumstances, be responsible for the acts or omissions of the packers or shippers. In circumstances where YA proposed handlers, packers or carriers if so requested, YA shall also not accept responsibility or liability for their acts or omissions.

7.3 Export license

The export of any lot from Malaysia or import into any other country may be subject to one or more export or import licences being granted. It is the buyer's responsibility to obtain any relevant export or import licence. - (v) to charge interest at a rate not exceeding 1.5% per month on the total amount due to the extent it remains unpaid for more than 7 days after the sale;
